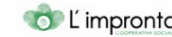

Bergamo Fast Track City

18 March 2019 → Bergamo became FTC
- 6 institutions
- 13 NGOs



Activities:

- Offer rapid, anonymous and free test for HIV, HCV and Syphilis
- Link to care new people with new diagnosis (Linkage to Care) or that aren't in ART yet (Retention in Care)
- Informations about HIV/AIDS, STIs, Sexual Health
- Training courses at high school
- Distributes multimedia and printed materials
- Spread informations on social network and website
- Self-help groups
- Delivery therapy
- Host PWHIV in social-healthcare facilities

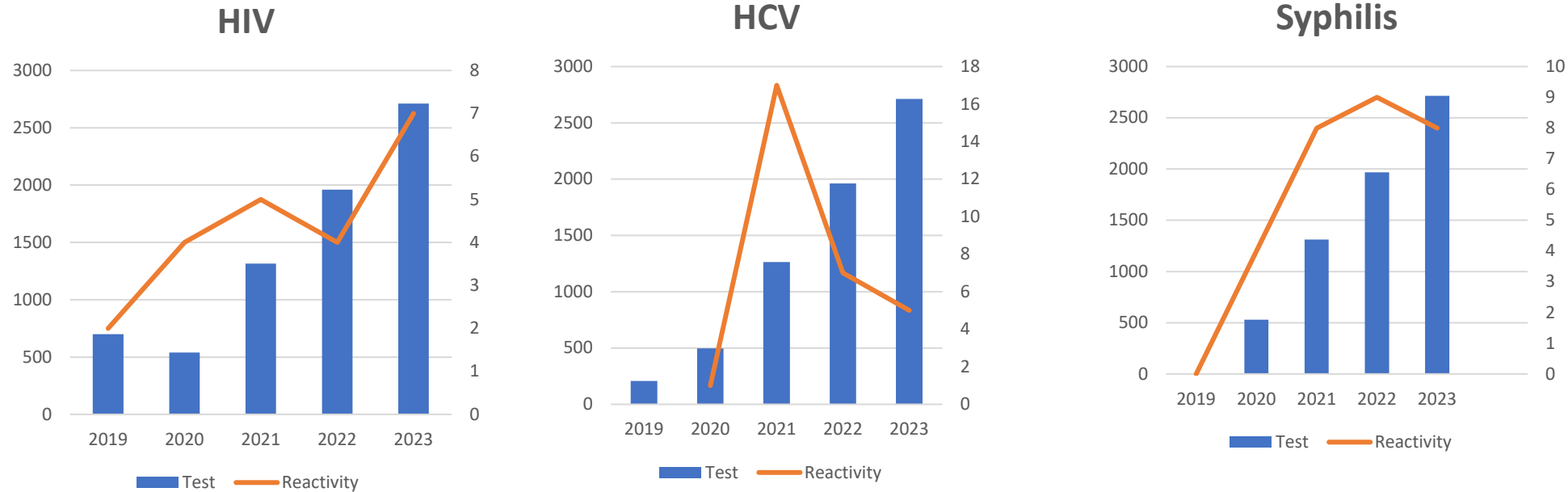
Testing activities – Bergamo Fast Track City		
Period	Place	Population reached
2019 - 2024	Test on the territory	General Population; Youth; MSM
2020 – 2024	Check Point	General Population; Youth; MSM
2022 – 2024	Test at NGOs that works with marginalities	SW, PWID, Homeless, Migrants, Trans

2019 -2023 Testing activities of Bergamo FTCl

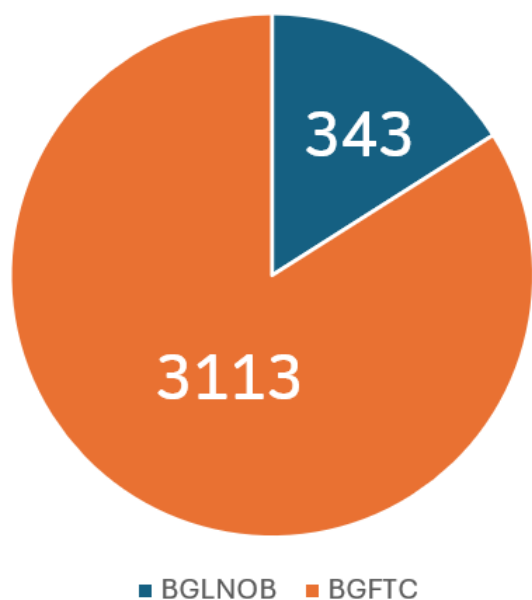


May 2019 – December 2023

- 550 testing events
- 7244 people for HIV, HCV and Syphilis
- 22 new diagnoses for HIV (0.31%), 30 for HCV (0.44%) and 29 for Syphilis (0.43%)

Testing among general and vulnerable population

Period: October 2022 to February 2024



Reactivity Incidence STIs
(HIV, HCV and Syphilis)
(october 2022 - february 2024)

Test on Vulnerable Population (BGLNOB project)

20 reactivities of 343 test = 5,83%

9 HIV+ = 2,6%
6 HCV+ = 1,7%
5 SYPHILIS+ = 1,5%

Test on general population

14 reactivities of 3113 test = 0,44%

2 HIV+ = 0,06%
2 HCV+ = 0,06%
10 SYPHILIS+ = 0,32%

Conclusion

Goal → 95-95-95 OMS

WHAT WE ARE DOING AND CONTINUE TO DO:

Testing activities:

- **Reach the undeclared** → specific activities among vulnerable and key populations
- **Generate awareness** → activities among general population and young people

Sensibilization activities:

- Spread informations about STIs
- Talk about Sexual Health

Win the fight against HIV/AIDS

→ Young people receive informations and generate informations ←
